

If you struggle with dry or wet areas of your landscaping, we recommend the following. The drought tolerant plants listed are the most likely to survive without irrigating once they are established. We do recommend applying mulch to retain moisture. Moisture tolerant plants are for areas naturally wet or boggy soil, or along a stream or small pond.
