

SHRUB PLANTING GUIDE



1

Dig hole twice as wide as root ball, at same depth.



2

Carefully remove pot and loosen or cut plant roots.



3

Place shrub in hole, slightly above existing grade.



4

Fill hole with 50% existing soil and 50%

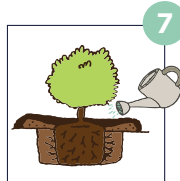

Make a basin to retain water. Fill 3 to 4 times with a mix of water and **Natural Alternatives Protilizer**. A shrub with a dry root ball can't absorb water, so make sure the shrub is not dry before planting.



6

Add a layer of mulch 2 to 3 inches thick, keeping it away from shrub stem.



7

Water thoroughly every 3 to 4 days during extreme heat or drought.
